This C.C.C. is filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act praying to initiate Contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobeying the order dated 12.1.2001 in W.P.No.607/2001.

This C.C.C. coming on for orders this day, Chief Justice made the following:

ORDER

This Contempt Petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order of this Court dated 12.1.2001, wherein, it has been directed that the respondents shall complete the enquiry within one month from the date of receipt of the objections by the complainant and to pass appropriate order. As per the direction of this Court dated 12.1.2001 and in compliance to Emergent notice, learned counsel for the 2nd respondent has filed a Memo stating that the 2nd respondent has passed an order on 30.8.2001. However, he submitted that the same could not be filed in time due to reasons beyond control and expressed his regret and unconditional apology



for the delay. On consideration, we condone the delay as the order has already been complied with.

Accordingly, this Contempt Petition is dismissed. Notice is discharged.
