within one month.

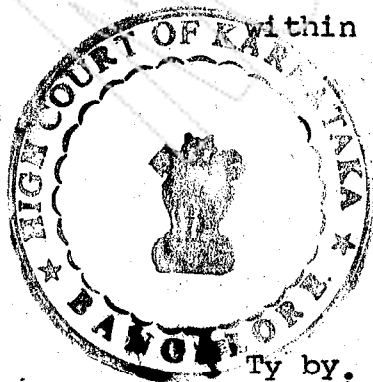
