This Miscellaneous First Appeal is filed under Section 173(1) of the MV Act against the judgment and award dated 19.3.03 passed in M.V.C. No.56/99 on the file of the Tribunal Chikballapur, has been referred to the Lok Adalat by the Hon'ble High Court under section 20 of the Legal Services Authority Act, 1987.

This appeal coming on for conciliation this day, **Ashok B. Hinchigeri, J.** delivered the following:

CONCILIATION ORDER

The appellants have agreed to receive a sum of Rs.1,94,000/- (Rupees one lakh ninety four thousand only) with interest at 6% per annum from the date of presentation of the claim petition till the date of payment, in addition to what has been awarded by the Tribunal. The respondent has agreed to pay the same.

2. However, if the respondent fails to deposit the amounts within two months from the date of preparation of the award, the amounts shall carry the interest at the rate of 9% per annum after the expiry of two months.
