This MSA is filed under section 54(2) of the Land Acquisition Act, against the Judgment and Decree dated 29-10-1990 passed by the Addl. Dist. Judge, Hassan, in MA No.47/88, dismissing the appeal and confirming the judgment and award dated 30-3-88 passed by the Civil Judge, Holenarasipura, in LAC No.269/84.

This petition coming on for hearing this day, the Court made the following:

ORDER

Heard the Government Advocate. 3034 days in refiling and 12 days in filing the appeal has been sought to be explained on the ground of

administrative delay. The extra-ordinary delay is not explained properly and there is absolutely no reason as to why this delay has been condoned. Even otherwise on merits, when the enhancement of compensation is so meagre, it is unnecessary to examine the merits. In the circumstances, I.As I and II are dismissed. Consequently, the appeal fails and hence dismissed.
