THIS APPEAL COMING ON FOR CONCILIAITION BEFORE LOK ADALAT AFTER BEING REFERRED VIDE ORDER DTD.17-01-2013, THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS PASSED.

**CONCILIATION ORDER**

The learned counsel for the appellants and the learned counsel for respondent – Insurance Company along with its representative are present.

2. After prolonged negotiations, the matter is settled. The Appellants have agreed to receive and the respondent – Insurance Company has agreed to pay a lump sum of Rs.2,36,000/- (Rupees

Two Lakh Thirty Six Thousand only) in addition to what has been awarded by the Tribunal, in full and final settlement of the claim. A joint Memo is filed on behalf of the parties to this effect.

3. The Respondent - Insurance Company has agreed to deposit the said amount before the Tribunal, within six weeks from the date of preparation of Award, failing which the said amount shall carry interest at 9% p.a. from the date of default, till the date of deposit.
4. The entire enhanced compensation amount shall be released in favour of the appellant.
5. This miscellaneous first appeal stands disposed of in terms of the Joint memo. The award of the Tribunal shall stand modified accordingly. Draw up the Award accordingly.
