THIS W.P. IS FILED UNDER ARTICLE 226 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA, PRAYING TO DIRECT THE RESPONDENTS TO CONSIDER THE REPRESENTATION AND THE APPLICATION FILED BY THE PETITIONERS BEFORE THEM AT ANN-D & D3 AND PASS APPROPRIATE ORDERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW.

THIS PETITION COMING ON FOR PRELIMINARY HEARING THIS DAY, THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING:

ORDER

In this writ petition, the petitioners have sought a direction to the respondents to consider their representations, copies of which are at Annexures-D to D3 and to pass orders in accordance with law.

2. Though the writ petition is listed for preliminary hearing, with the consent of counsel on both sides, it is heard finally.

3. Briefly stated, it is the case of the petitioners that the second petitioner is the daughter of the first petitioner. That the first petitioner was granted land to an extent of

24 acres in Sy.No.209 now denoted as Sy.No.267 of Pandaravalli Village Jagara Hobli, Chikmagalur Taluk, for the purpose of coffee cultivation. The said lands are proposed to be acquired for Bhadra Tigre Reserve. The petitioners apprehending that the lands would be acquired, has sought grant of coffee kharab lands belonging to the State Government in Sy.Nos.194 and 195 of the same village, which are now said to be in their possession, in lieu of surrendering the land in Sy.No.267. In that regard, they have made representations at Annexures-D to D3 to the respondents concerned for consideration of their case. The prayer in this writ petition is to direct the respondents to consider the representations in accordance with law and pass appropriate orders.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Pleader for the respondents and perused the material on record.

5. Without going into the rights and contentions of either of the parties, a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider the representations at Annexures-D to D3 dated 18/09/2013 and 08/10/2013 in accordance with law.

6. The writ petition is disposed of with the foresaid direction.
