This MFA filed U/s 173(1) of MV Act against the judgment and award dated 21.09.2011 passed in MVC No.659/2010 on the file of the Presiding Officer, Fast Track Court, MACT, Kundapura, partly allowing the claim petition for compensation and seeking enhancement of compensation.

This Appeal coming on for conciliation before Lok Adalath after being referred vide order dated 14.11.2013, the following conciliation order is passed.

CONCILIATION ORDER

Learned Counsel for the appellant and the Insurance Company and Officers of Insurance Company present.

2. After going through the records and hearing them, it is found that a sum of Rs.65,000/- is found to be just and reasonable compensation and the same shall be deposited in



MACT within four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the award and this shall not carry any interest.

3. If there is any failure to deposit the said amount within the time stipulated by this Lok Adalath, it shall carry interest at 6% p.a. from the date of default till payment.

4. As the amount in question does not earn substantial interest, the entire amount shall be paid to the claimant.
